## State Order

Gov. Jared Polis on Wednesday issued a statewide stay-at-home order, effective 6 a.m. today, March 26, 2020 through April 11, 2020.

Polis' order Wednesday followed similar measures in seven other counties including the Tri-County Health Department, which covers Douglas, Adams and Arapahoe counties and the Jefferson County Health Department.

Polis acknowledged some of the confusion that arose when it came to having a
