Small businesses: still need money?

There are still financial resources available for small businesses affected by COVID-19:

Mini-Grants

Business operations mini-grants have a maximum award value of \$2,500 per business applicant to use for operational upgrades.

Technology upgrades mini-grants have a maximum award value of \$1,000 per business applicant to use for items like point-of-sale terminals or systems.

Compliance issues mini-grants have a maximum award value of \$1,000 per business applicant to use for expenses such as legal support or guidance for operations during COVID-19.

Small Business Stabilization Program

Funding can provide short-term working capital assistance to small businesses to enable retention of jobs and provide organizational stability.
