Capital Grant Applications Due July 1

Looking to build out a new space, purchase a new piece of equipment, or make other capital improvements to your business? Apply for the Small Business Capital Project Grant before the July 1 cutoff and you could be eligible to receive a 10% reimbursement of your total project cost, with a maximum grant amount of \$5,000.

Eligible Project Criteria:

Real Property Improvements | a permanent addition to, or betterment of, real property that enhances the capital value (roofing, siding, flooring, painting, plumbing, etc.)

Tangible Property Purchases | depreciable assets purchased for direct and sole use by the business which have an estimated useful life of three (3) years or more (furniture, fixtures, equipment, etc.)
